When:

Wants to avoid or receive life-sustaining treatment.

Where:

• Resides in a long-term care facility or requires long-term care services.

•Might die within the next year

MOLST

More Of Life Still Time - MOLST Ask yourself the question is there More Of Life and is there Still Time

Are you still enjoying what life has to offer

Are you suffering

MOLST Advance Directives & HCP's

MLOST - <u>Binding</u> – cannot be changed in an instant

Advance Directives- a persons *wishes* pertaining to medical choices

HCP's- person you selected to speak on your behalf in the event you are not able to make your wishes known

MOLST FAQ's

Reviewed every 90 days by Md NP Pa Can be changed by the person or HCP Although bright pink is missed on occasion
