Natural Occurring Retirement Community

NORC

Coordinate a broad range of health and social services to help support older adults age in their own homes. A NORC program is to facilitate and integrate the health, maintenance, and social services already available in the community, to help older adults remain at home.

Home Care

Provides assistance with meal preparation, shopping, light housekeeping and assistance with Daily Living activities such as bathing, dressing and medication reminders.

Long Term Care Insurance (LTC)

- Insurance that helps pay for Home Care services, Assisted Living and Nursing Home.
- You purchase an amount of money for a term period
- Premiums
- Waiting Period

- For people over the age of 55
- Limited Amenities provided local van transportation, pool, activities room, club house, golf course, tennis courts

Assisted Living

- Provides assistance with daily living activities meals, medication management, bathing, dressing, transferring.
- Offers social activities, trips, lectures, wellness programs.
- Social programs are designed based on the resident's individual interests.
- Accommodations are studio and one bedroom apartments with kitchenettes.








Assisted Living/Memory Support

- An assisted living program designed for people with Dementia.
- Services and programs designed for those with special needs providing a safe and caring environment.





Assisted Living Program-ALP

- Medicaid Program
- Intermittent support with ADL's
- Meals, medication management, activities, trips, housekeeping, personal laundry







Nursing Home – Short Term and Long Term Care

- Short term rehabilitation after a hospital stay. Medicare pays in full up to 20 days. Above 20 days, Medicare pays 80% and supplemental pays the remaining 20%.
- Long term care is for residents who need skilled 24-hour care.
